SHORE LEAVE FOR CREW WORKING ONBOARD VESSELS VISITING THE PORT OF SINGAPORE

- 1. With effect from 1 April 2022, fully vaccinated ships' crew visiting the Port of Singapore will be granted shore leave.
- 2. Singapore has continued to monitor the local and global COVID-19 situation following the launch of the Vaccinated Travel Framework (VTF).
- 3. From 26 April 2022, 0001 hours fully vaccinated¹ ships' crew who wish to go ashore while in the port shall present the following documents to the Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) officer at the check points²:
 - a. Valid overseas/Singapore vaccination certificate;
 - b. Valid passport;
 - c. SGAC/e-HDC³; and
 - d. Valid visa (if applicable)

¹ An individual is considered fully vaccinated two weeks after he or she has received two doses of Pfizer-BioNTech/ Comirnaty, Moderna, or any vaccines in the World Health Organisation's Emergency Use Listing such as Sinovac-CoronaVac, Sinopharm, and AstraZeneca.

² Authorised Landing Places such as Marina South Pier, West Coast Pier, Jurong Fishery Port or designated Port gates. The 5 designated Ports Gates for crew clearance are Keppel Entrance Crew Clearance Office (at Keppel Terminal Free Trade Zone), Pasir Panjang Crew Clearance Office (at Pasir Panjang Terminal Free Trade Zone), Sembawang Gate (at Sembawang Wharves Free Trade Zone), Jurong Port Main Gate Crew Clearance Office (at Jurong Port Free Trade Zone) and Tuas Port Crew Clearance Office (at Tuas Port Free Trade Zone).
